PUPPY ADOPTION PROCESS

- Puppies will go home with food, chews, treats as well as a new toy and blanket with familiar 'home scents'.
- A nice binder will be provided with many educational articles to help raise your puppy in a healthy and happy environment and good care. Copies of health tests done on the parents of your puppy will be enclosed too.
- The breeder will pay for a year subscription to THE BULLDOGGER, the BCA official publication.
- All puppies will be registered with AKC, and the registered name must include Breeder's kennel name; BLOSSOMING.
- Breeder will register each puppy with AKC after buyer has picked out its' call name.
- All puppies are evaluated at approximately seven weeks between 8/10 weeks for show potential.
- All puppies will have received age-appropriate vaccinations prior to leaving for their new forever homes.
- Puppies may go to their new homes at approximately nine to ten weeks of age.

- It is your responsibility to have your puppy examined by your veterinarian within 72 hours of taking possession of your puppy.
- Companion pet puppies are sold only with a spay/neuter agreement, with limited registration documentation. Proof of spay or neuter will be sent to Breeder (surgery done no sooner than 12 months of age).
- Show potential puppies sold with full registration will be co-owned with breeder until championship title has been achieved, and any other breeding requirements have been met. (ie, health testing)
- Please contact us directly to discuss show availability, price, deposit, terms of ownership,etc.
- Should you accept the terms and conditions of the purchaser's contract, you
 will be asked to send a non refundable deposit of \$100.00 to hold your puppy.
 The deposit IS refundable should the appropriate puppy not be found in this
 litter (gender, show quality) We won't know until delivery whether we have
 enough males and females to fit everyone's preferences. Your visits are
 always welcome too!
